Hitherto although each mounted man has been supplied with a Pistol, he has had no way of carrying ammunition - I have therefore submitted for your approbation a method of fitting up the holster pipe in which the tomahawk is now carried, (and without interfering with it) so that in case of necessity half a dozen cartridges may be carried with it -

The cost of the fittings will be four shillings for each saddle, for which an authority is required.
